YMCA MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATION AND GUIDELINES

1. FOR RED TRIANGLE CLUB: Any pupil enrolled from Grade III to VI is qualified to join the Red Triangle Club upon payment of FIVE PESOS ONLY (P 5.00) as their membership fee.

FOR HI-Y CLUB: Any student enrolled in the high school from 1st year to 4th year is qualified to join the Hi-Y Club upon payment of SEVEN PESOS OMLY (P 7.00) as their membership fee.

- 2. Prepare the list of pupils with corresponding Club Adviser/s duly noted by the Principal and/or by the District Supervisor.
- 3. Submit the list of club members and officers including the collected membership fees to the YMCA office not later than August 31, 2008 and ask for official receipt and IDs.
- 4. Request for orientation meeting schedule for your club and see to it that membership lds are issued to all members. And
- 5. If you don't have an existing club, it is suggested but not required that Social Studies teacher or School Paper Adviser be assigned to spearhead the organization of the respective YMCA Club and to coordinate with the Quezon City YMCA Office at #109 Benitez St., Cubao, Quezon City at Telefax No. 725 4582

NOTE:

- 1. The membership of Club Adviser/s in the amount of FIFTY PESOS ONLY (P 50.00) shall be taken from any available fund from the local school club fund.
- 2. The amount of TWO PESOS (P 2.00) from each student membership fee shall be retained by the Club/ School for its operational expenses subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedure of the Division Office.
- 3. For monitoring purposes, Club Advisers are required to submit to the Assistant Superintendent assigned to the District duplicate and/or Xerox copy of the list of their members and the amount of membership collected and submitted to the YMCA Office.
