

- 1. The Magna Kultura Foundation in coordination with the Department of Education's Task Force on School Sports (TFSS) and the National Capital Region's (NCR) PESS Division shall conduct free sports clinics on Filipino traditional games, dubbed as Larong Pinoy, in selected elementary schools in NCR. It will be officially launched on October 21, 2008 at the North Fairview Elementary School, North Fairview, Quezon City.
- 2. The Larong Pinoy is in consonance with the Traditional Games Project (Laro Ng Lahi) under the School Sports Competition Program of the TFSS. School sports activities are offered to help retain children in the schools.
- 3. The objectives of the Larong Pinoy are to: a) promote nationalism; b) strengthen family ties; c) involve the community in worthwhile activities; and e) keep the children in school through sports.
- 4. Identified elementary schools in NCR with a pupil population of 3,000 and above were chosen as recipients of the one-day sports clinic. The activities of the clinic include orientation and instructions on the Larong Pinoy, and games (tumbang preso, patintero and piko).
- 5. The Magna Kultura Foundation shall provide the schools with game instruction booklets, CD-ROM, game kit with a variety of Larong Pinoy equipment and other logistical requirements, while the DepEd shall facilitate the conduct of the clinics.

SUBJECT: LARONG PINOY SPORTS CLINIC

Stated hereunder, in connection with the sports clinic that will be conducted in Public Elementary schools here in the National Capital Region, are the conduct of activities that will be implemented from February to March, and will resume on July to November, as follows:

- 1. The Larong Pinoy Clinic will be conducted in 150 public schools, free-of charge, with all materials and trainers provided by Magna Kultura.
- 2. The Larong Pinoy Clinic will cater to elementary students from grades 1 grade 6.
- 3. The schedule of sports clinic will be based on the agreed accommodation schedule with each school. Furthermore, Magna Kultura will also be open to conducting the program during the school's foundation day.
- 4. The duration of the School Clinic program will last for a minimum of 40 minutes per session; or, as the school may decide, it may be implemented for a 3 hours full session with game drills.
- 5. Materials to be used for announcing the sports clinic will be via:
 - o Information Leaflets
 - o Schedule Announcement Banners
 - o Newspaper Publicity Announcements

During April to May, Magna Kultura will also be conducting summer sports clinics in selected schools to provide the youth with a worthwhile activity during the summer months. Arrangements will be made with participating schools for permission to use their campus grounds and letters sent to student's parents. In addition, the school's P.E. faculty staff supervising and assisting during the summer sports clinics will be provided with an honoraria allowance during the event day activity.

All aforementioned activities will be implemented in coordination under the office of Dr. Noemi Bellosillo, with regular coordination status reports and event completion reports.

We hope that everything is in order.

May our partnership efforts foster the revival of "Laro ng Lahi" among the generation of young Filipinos.
