

Greetings!



We are Paul and Sigrid Perez from PlayUniversal Co., a social enterprise dedicated to promoting the benefits of play in the total development of children in the Philippines. As our first endeavor, we are mounting the very first international festival on children's play called **PLAY PILIPINAS 2011** on 21-23 October, 2011 at the SMX Convention Center, Pasay City.

We've chosen to call it a festival because it is essentially a celebration of play. Our goal is to bring into the national consciousness the power of play in children's total well-being and to emphasize it as an inviolable right as stated in Article 31 of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child.

This festival will be bringing together educators and concerned parents, to share ideas on the current state of play in the country, and note the developments of play in other countries.

PLAY PILIPINAS 2011 has 3 components: The Forum, The Fairs and the Playspace Design Contest.

For the Forum, we have invited expert resource persons from Japan, Australia and the UK, as well as respected local experts to share their unique perspectives on the subject. Already, six respected figures in the field have confirmed their participation, and will give their insights during the conference:

Dr. Lourdes "Honey" Carandang - The pioneer of group play therapy for children in the country, Dr. Carandang has spearheaded many research and intervention projects for organizations such as UNICEF, International Labor Organization and our local Department of Social Welfare and Development.

Mr. Hitoshi Shimamura --- A play worker at the Sakai Adventure Playground Park in Tokyo, Mr. Shimamura is also Regional Vice President for East Asia/Pacific of the International Play Association and a member of the Japanese Adventure Playgrounds Association.

Professor Geraldine Naughton --- A respected pediatric exercise scientist, Professor Naughton's extensive track record includes research grants and publications in musculoskeletal health of intensively training adolescents, injury surveillance of pediatric sports-related injuries, and innovations in family-friendly weight management support for overweight children.

Professor Anita Bundy --- Known internationally for her work in occupational therapy assessment and intervention, Professor Bundy has published widely and has given lectures and courses on five continents. She is best known for developing theory and research on sensory integration and on play with children who have disabilities.

She is currently an adjunct professor at Miriam College and at the University of Asia & the Pacific.

Dr. Maria Theresa Gustilo-Villasor --- A clinical psychologist by profession, Dr. Villasor is affiliated with the Psychological Association of the Philippines, the American Psychological Association, and the International Council of Psychologists. She also teaches at the Center for Family Ministries (CEFAM) at Ateneo de Manila University, and the Graduate School of Counselor Education in De La Salle University-Manila (DLSU).

And that's just a partial list of speakers, as we will continue to secure commitments from other distinguished guests in the coming weeks.

Apart from being able to listen to our speakers above, each participant to the forum will also get a chance to attend a workshop of their choice: Music and Play by MLAC (Dr. Honey Carandang's Institute), Toy Analysis by UP-Manila, Larong Pinoy Workshops, Poi and Outdoor Play and Integrating Play into the Curriculum or Programs facilitated by experts in their respective fields.

Being a celebration of play, we're also bringing fun and imagination to the festivities. A highlight of our affair will be the **Playspace Design Challenge**. Here, the finalists' designs will each be brought to life on a 100-sqm area --- open to grown-ups and children alike, for one and all to experience and enjoy.

The 3-day festival also has a variety of fairs and exhibits designed for children and adults to fully immerse in the world of play. The World Toys Exhibit showcases the very best of games and toys from different countries around the world. At the Schools Fair, parents will get to know the different approaches to learning and programs available for their children. Then there are also the Toy-, Books-, Children's Nutrition and Children's Fashion Fairs for the general public.

Play Pilipinas 2011 is open to one and all. And since this is the first of its kind in the country, we feel it will be able to achieve its goal with an endorsement from your good office.
