Date : July 23, 2009

The Metrobank Foundation has invited the League of Cities of the Philippines to be part of the LGU committee for the re-launching of Teachers' Month Campaign (TMC). This is in line with the World Teachers' Day which was proclaimed by the UNESCO in 1993. The first day of the campaign will coincide with Metrobank's 47th anniversary celebration on September 4 highlighted by the awarding of the Metrobank Foundation's Search for Outstanding Teachers and will culminate on October 5 as World Teachers' Day. The TMC Council of Leaders composed of offices from the sectors of government, business, mass media, and non-government organizations will be at the forefront of the campaign.

Among the objectives of the TMC are a) to generate widespread awareness and support for the Teachers' Day; b) to celebrate the unique role that teachers play in nation building; c) to revitalize the image of teaching as a vocation; d) to enhance the viability of a teaching career through scholarships and subsidy programs; and e) to affirm current and retired teachers.

As a member of the LGU committee, the consortium has invited the LCP to:

- Coordinate with its member cities to encourage them to celebrate October 5 as 'World Teachers' Day
- Encourage LCEs to hold activities in their respective communities to honor and express gratitude to teachers
- Help advocate teachers' welfare and development among local government officials
- Tap other institutions that can help LGUs.

Being part of the team, the Philippine Daily Inquirer and the Philippine Star have pledged to feature select activities that will be conducted for the teachers during the celebration.

Everyone concerned is hereby encouraged to disseminate this Memorandum.
