Teachers' Month Campaign and World Teachers' Day

1. With the theme "My Teacher, My Hero," the 2010 Teachers' Month Campaign will start on September 3, 2010 and culminate on October 5, 2010 to coincide with the World Teachers' Day.

- 2. Pursuant thereto, all students led by the Supreme Student Governments (SSGs) nationwide shall actively take part in the Teachers' Month Campaign.
- 3. As such, the school-based SSGs shall convene the Coordinating Council for Co-Curricular Organizations and, together with all school-based clubs or organizations, must initiate/organize the following activities during the month-long celebration:
 - a. Post posters and information on the SSG Builetin Boards paying tribute to teachers and hang streamers/tarpaulins honoring teachers;
 - b. Hold competitions such as greeting card-making, poster making, slogan-making, song-writing and other activities relevant to the theme of the celebration;
 - c. Coordinate with LGUs and NGOs for the SSG's Teachers' Month Campaign activities;
 - d. Conduct a culminating activity highlighted by a Tribute Program, Parlor Games/Sportsfest, parade and other leisure and fun activities for teachers; and,
 - e. Recognize teachers' efforts by giving awards to both active and retired teachers during the Tribute Program.
- 4. The activities for the Teachers' Month Campaign shall be undertaken by the SSGs and other school-based clubs or organizations in the most creative, festive and memorable way possible.
- 5. Expenses for the activities to be undertaken by the SSGs are chargeable against SSG Developmental Funds and/or donations from government and private sponsors.
