

Greetings from the U.P. College of Music - Music Education Department!

In celebration of the 95th anniversary of the UP College of Music and the 44th anniversary of the Music Education Department, the Music Education Department in cooperation with the Philippine Society for Music Education and the U.P. Junior Music Educators' Guild would like to invite teachers from the NCR and nearby provinces to the Teaching Demonstration Series 15 at the Abelardo Hall, U.P. College of Music this coming September 9, 2011 from 1:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. This year's theme is "UbD: Teaching with Musical Understanding."

The objective of the project is to update pre-school, elementary and secondary school music teachers/teachers teaching music on teaching techniques based on current trends and learning theories as well as instructional materials in the teaching of Music.
