



1. Participating Choir Shall Perform 2 Choral Pieces of their Own Choice, One Filipino and One English	5 pts.
2. Choir Group Must Have a Maximum of 30 Members excluding the Conductor and/or Instrumentalist.	5 pts. more than 30 students

3. 8-10 Minutes Performance	5 pts. less than 8 minutes or more than 10 minutes and playing over 20 seconds will be stopped.
4. Accompaniment is Limited to Piano, Organ, Guitar or could be Acapela	5 pts.
5. Songs can be sing with or without Choreography	
6. No medley	5 Pts.
In case no Piano is available at the Contest Venue, Taped Accompaniment of Piano or Organ can be used.

- 4. Illustration Board will be provided by the Organizers.
- 5. Participants will have 3 hours to finish their poster.
- 6. There will be no coaching allowed in the contest. Participants who are caught with a coach will be disqualified

E. BASKETBALL

- 1. Only One team for each School District.
- 2. Only 12 players per District.
- 3. Selection of players will be done and managed by each District.
- 4. Only Champion and First Runner-Up will be awarded by Cash Prize and Trophy.
- 5. Rules and Regulation of Knockout System will be discussed and adopted by representatives of each District and submitted to Rotary Club of Kamuning at 2nd Floor Vice Mayor's Office on or before September 11, 2009.

F. QUIZ BEE

- City Schools of Quezon City will provide all the Mechanics, Rules and Regulation.

ADDENDUM TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS, AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 1. Registration is extended up to September 10 only, for both Elementary and Secondary levels.
- 2. Strictly no registration will be accepted after September 10.
- 3. Final submission of the Numbers and Names of participants in each event will be on September 11. Only those who complied with the requirements will receive the Certificate of Participation and other tokens of appreciation if funds are available.
- 4. Five (5) points will be deducted to registered competitors who will not be joining the parade.
- 5. During the parade, drum and lyre bands are requested to play, and, if possible, choir and rondalla are also encouraged to sing and play respectively.
- 6. Display of school banners are also requested and school cheer squads can also join the parade.
- 7. In case there are only three (3) to four (4) participants in the event, there will only be one (1) winner. For five (5) to six (6) participants, only a champion and a first runner up will be chosen.
- 8. Contests not specified or included in this memo are not included in the event.
- 9. Certificates of participation and tokens of appreciation (if funds are available) will be distributed during the on-site registration on September 26 between 6:00 am to 7:20 am. These include students who have been eliminated in events where there are elimination processes.
