In this regard, may we request for the immediate information dissemination of the scholarship to the schools under your supervision?

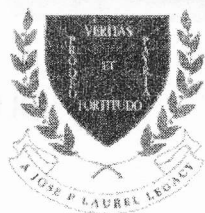

I. COURSES COVERED

- Accountancy

II. PRIVILEGES

III. SELECTION CRITERIA

- Must be a current 4th year high school student or a qualified candidate for graduation.
- MUST BELONG TO THE TOP 10% OF THE GRADUATING CLASS OF AT LEAST 35 STUDENTS.
- Must be of good moral character as certified by the high school principal.
- Must be a Filipino citizen
- Must pass the qualifying examination and interview given by the scholarship committee.

IV. REQUIREMENTS

- Accomplished application form
- Certification from the high school principal stating:
 - Class rank of applicant among the total number of graduating students based on the recent grading period
 - Good moral character of the applicant
- Two 2x2 recent, identical photographs, with signature over printed name at the back
- Photocopy of birth certificate
- Two long brown envelopes – Nursing applicants;
One long brown envelope – other courses

V. SCHEDULE OF QUALIFYING EXAMINATION

Application may be submitted starting October
Examinations is on November and December

NOTE:

- Applications should be submitted at least a week before the intended testing date.
- All students coming from laboratory / science high schools are automatically qualified to apply.
