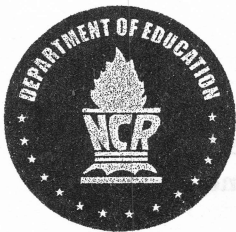

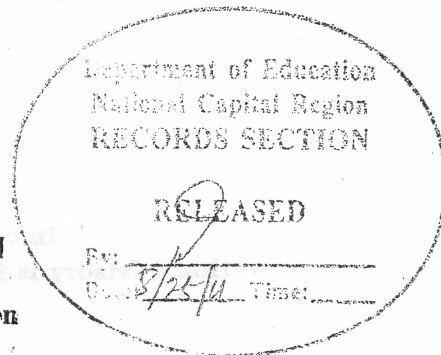



1. **Who May Join**
Open to all full time/part time students, classified per category:
Junior Division : Grades 1-7
High School Division : Years I-IV
College Division : University Level
2. **Essay Theme**
Junior Division : "Who is General Miguel Malvar? What Makes Him My Hero?"
High School Division : "Who is General Miguel Malvar, the 2nd President of the Philippines?"
College Division : "Who is General Miguel Malvar in the Context of Modern Society Today?"
3. **Format Criteria**
Junior Division : minimum of 1,000 words and maximum of 1,500 words
High School and College Divisions : minimum of 2,000 words and maximum of 4,000 words
4. **Contest Period**
The period for submission of entries started in June and the deadline will be on August 31, 2011 via postal mail, delivery, or e-mail.
5. **Prizes**
Junior Division – PhP20,000; PhP15,000; and PhP10,000 for the first, second, and third place winners, respectively; PhP5,000 each for 5 consolation prizes
High School Division – PhP30,000; PhP20,000; and PhP10,000 for the first, second, and third place winners, respectively.
College Division – PhP30,000; PhP20,000; and PhP10,000 for the first, second, and third place winners, respectively.

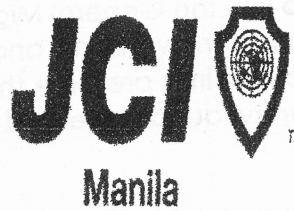
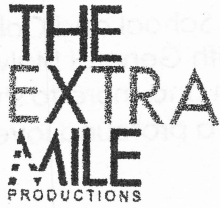
