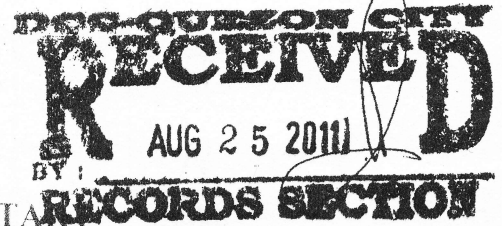



*WHEREAS, public school teachers should be trained to serve as disaster marshals who can identify hazards in their respective school premises. X*




NOW, THEREFORE,




