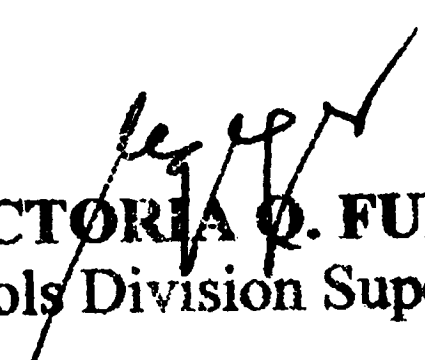
Subject: DOST Scholarship Examination

The 2010 DOST-SEI Undergraduate Science and Technology Scholarships are now open to qualified applicants. To select the new awardees, the scholarship examination will be administered simultaneously on 15 November 2009 (Sunday) at designated test centers nationwide.

A number of scholarship applicants come from high schools in Quezon City, CAMANAVA and Marikina. In view of this, may we request for three (3) possible test centers in Quezon City considering the strategic location and the following facilities/requirements: one big room or hall which can accommodate 100-150 examinees per session (AM/PM); chairs with writing desks; sound system; whiteboard or blackboard with eraser and chalk; and table and chair for the DOST Examiner.

The services of a sound system technician and a janitor shall be required also and they will be given a service fee of P200.00 each per session. A DOST Examiner will visit the school within the week before the examination to make final arrangements in setting-up the testing hall.

We will highly appreciate your preferential action on our request. One of our staff will coordinate with your office regarding this matter.
