

GUIDELINES

I. THEME: MOBILIZING EDUCATION FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

II. OBJECTIVES:

- A. Emphasize the importance of education for balanced and healthful ecology;
- B. Give evidence to the importance of education in promoting environmental protection and conservation;
- C. Pay tribute to the founders of The National Teachers College;
- D. Give recognition to secondary school students who excel in the field of elocution.

The contest is open to secondary school students enrolled in either public or private schools. Each school is entitled to one participant only.
