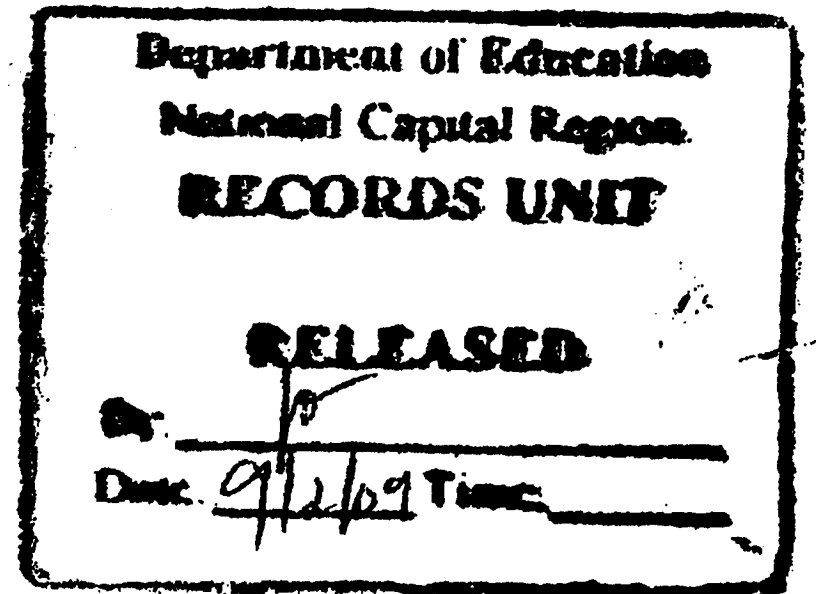

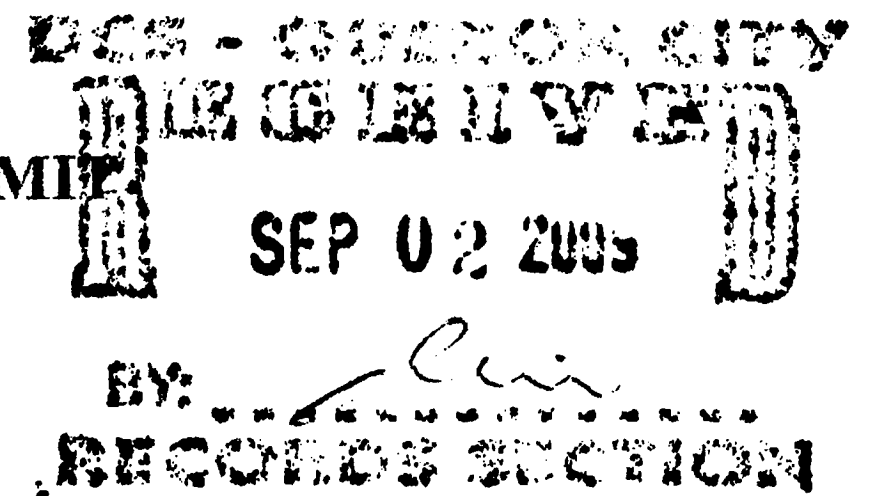

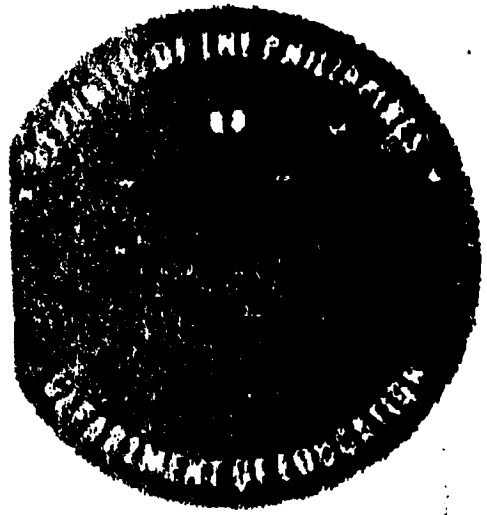

YOUTH ENTREPRENEURSHIP SUMMIT

1. The Philippine Center for Entrepreneurship and Presidential Consultant for Entrepreneurship Jose Ma. A. Concepcion III, in cooperation with the Department of Education, are organizing the **GO NEGOSYO Youth Entrepreneurship Summit** on 11 September 2009 from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, at the SMX Complex, SM Mall of Asia, Pasay City.
2. The Youth Entrepreneurship Summit aims to achieve the following:
 - a. promote a mindset of optimism and a culture of entrepreneurship among the youth;
 - b. enhance entrepreneurship lessons under the Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) and the *Edukasyong Pantahan at Pangkabuhayan* (EPP);
 - c. expose students, teachers and administrators in real entrepreneurial undertakings to develop their entrepreneurial knowledge, skills and attitudes; and,
 - d. encourage students to engage in actual entrepreneurial endeavors and improve the management of personal finances of teachers and administrators.
2. The summit involves a whole day of meaningful and interactive event featuring different inspiring entrepreneurial topics, informative sessions and *negosyo* models for the youth. Admission is free.

3. Being an opportunity for and as our commitment to entrepreneurship learning, all Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) third and fourth year high school students and their teachers with business management subject, and those involved in the Youth Entrepreneurship and Cooperativism in Schools (YECS) and the Student Technologists and Entrepreneurs of the Philippines (STEP), including *Edukasyong Pantahan* at *Pangkabuhayan* (EPP) teachers, are enjoined to fully and actively participate in the **GO NEGOSYO Youth Entrepreneurship Summit** by organizing field trips to attend the one-day event. A Certificate of Attendance will be issued to administrators, students and teacher-participants after the event.
4. To maximize the learning during the summit, all student-attendees shall be required to submit a journal on their key learning for the entire day or a project to be determined by the accompanying teachers or administrators relative to the learning during the event.
5. Transportation, per diems and other incidental expenses of participants are chargeable against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. The Regional and Division Supervisors in-charge of Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) shall coordinate the participation of all concerned.
