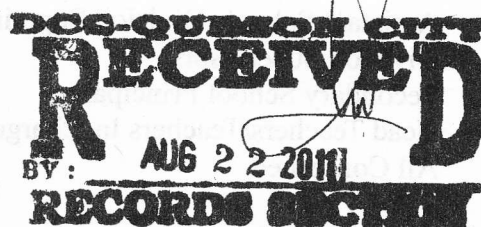

Transportation: Event organizer to provide buses to transport 2nd to 4th year students and teachers to and from the videoconference.

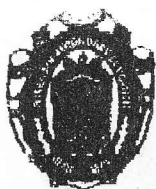

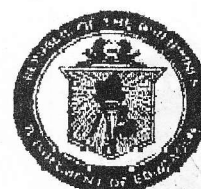
