Subject: Campaign for Increased Membership In the Boy Scouts of the Philippines

Attached is Regional Letter No. 301, s. 2010, encouraging all schools divisions to campaign for an increase in membership of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines through activities that propagate the scouting spirit and values that can be derived from this movement.

It is observed that out of 1.7 million members that the Boy Scouts of the Philippines had in the past, only 172,000 boy scouts have registered as of June 2010. This is roughly only 10.11% of the previous membership. In Quezon City, out of the membership goal of 65,000, only 1,746, or 2.69%, have registered as of June 2010.

Considering the importance of the Scouting movement in providing activities that enrich our children's experiences in school, particularly in skills development and values formation, this Office enjoins all schools/institutions to intensify their campaign for membership in the Scouting movement by soliciting the cooperation and support of the local government unit such as the barangay, the non - government organizations in the community, and the parents.

Immediate and wide dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
