Warm Greetings!

The Teachers Dignity Coalition (TDC) will be having its first National Convention on October 3-5 at the Manila Grand Opera Hotel, Avenida Rizal corner Doroteo Jose St., Sta Cruz, Manila.

This National Convention, which endorsed by no less than the DepEd Secretary on a memorandum dated September 4, 2009, would gather 600 teachers, school heads and other education personnel from 17 regions of the country. A minimal registration fee of P2, 500.00 to cover board and lodging, seminar kit, meals and other expenses shall be collected from each participant. The culmination of the Convention is a gathering of 10,000 teachers at the Rizal Stadium to be followed by a cultural caravan to the main offices of the GSIS and Senate to highlight the plight of education sector workers.

In this light may we request your good office to allow and support the attendance of Quezon City delegates to this very important event.

Furthermore, may we also request for a memorandum enjoining all the school heads and teachers of this division to participate the World Teachers' Day celebration dubbed as "Unity for teachers' Dignity" which will be the culminating program of this Convention. Another memorandum from the office of the secretary endorsing this October 5 event is expected to be released this week. All schools division superintendents of Regions III, IV-A and NCR are likewise invited to attend this particular activity.
