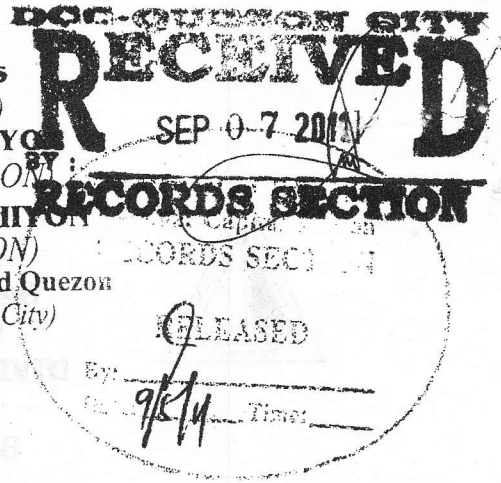

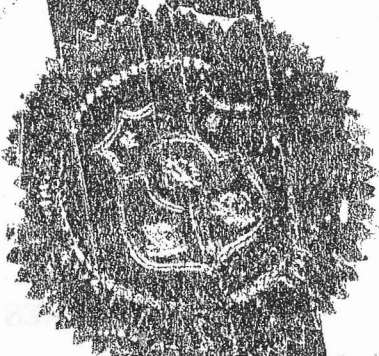

SCHOLARSHIP ASSOCIATION INC.**

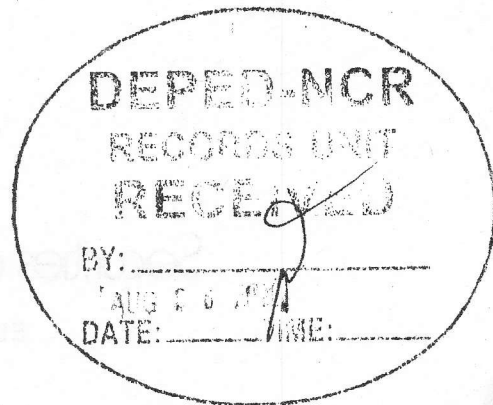
