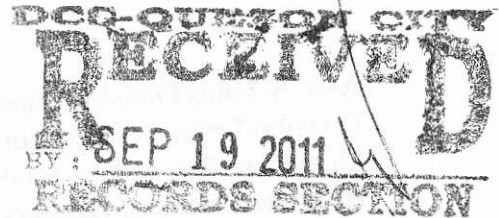

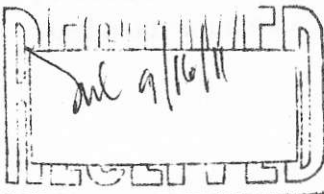



In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (R.A.) 7722, otherwise known as the "*Higher Education Act of 1994*", this Office hereby endorses the subject undertaking organized by the DFM Educational Center and Northwest Placement, Inc. for the support and participation of all concerned.

This event, dubbed as "*Tribute to Teachers on World Teachers' Day*" and which aims to pay respect to and honor teachers around the world, is composed of two parts.
