



Bantay Liskuwela is a school-based procurement watch project that aims to increase the awareness of Parents, Teachers, and Community Association (PTCA) and other civil society organizations on procurer transparency and accountability reforms through monitoring the procurement and delivery of elementary and secondary armchairs. This capacity-building project hopes to achieve good procurement outcomes and generate reliable information and feedback to support Department of Education's (DepEd) efforts to decentralize procurement and minimize leakages in education spendin |-

Last April 28 and 29, 2009, Procurement Watch, Inc. (PWI) and volunteers from Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Girl Scouts of the Philippines, PTCA, and the VANGUARD conducted the beginning inventory in pilot schools located within the division of Quezon City. The initial list of schools was based on the allocation list for school armchairs provided by the DepEd Central Office.

During the course of the project, it was brought to PWI's attention that there were significant changes in the a location list. New schools were named as beneficiaries and there was a change in the quantity of allocated armchairs for delivery in each school. This has therefore invalidated the beginning inventory exercise held on April 2009.

Due to the changes, PWI felt the need to respond accordingly and start the activity anew. This would entail the conduct of the beginning inventory for the new schools included in the list for the 2nd district of Quezon City. As part of the project activities, Bantay Eskuwela volunteers opt to conduct, in close coordination with the schools concerned, the following activities on September 26, October 3, and October 10, 2009:

1. Beginning inventory,

2. Actual count which would determine whether technical specifications are met, and if the quantity of school furniture corresponds to the allocation list, and

3. Ending count.

PWI in requesting that the activities be conducted during Saturdays so that classroom activities will not be disrupted. An endorsement letter from Usec. Bacani has been attached for reference. As such, we would like to request the Quezon City Division Office to endorse us to the principals of the schools concerned. The schools and the proposed schedule are listed below.
