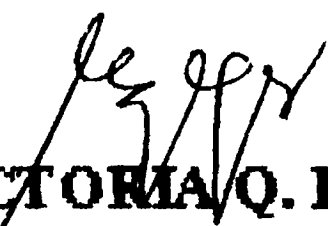

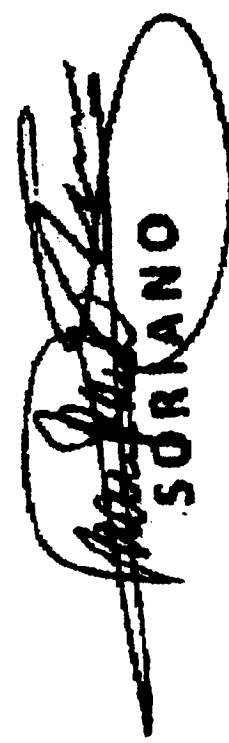
RE: Green Film Festival at SM Malls
