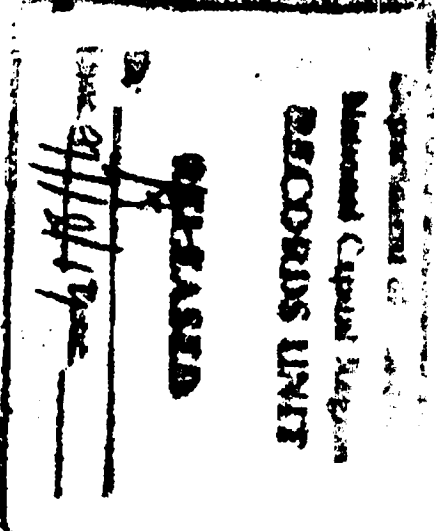

Warm greetings!

October 5 is World Teachers' Day. This year's World Teachers' Day theme is: **Build our Future: Invest in our Teachers**. In line with this theme and as part of our commitment to the more than 700,000 teaching and non-teaching personnel nationwide, we uphold to continuously work for the betterment of their welfare and economic conditions in life. This is why on October 5 of this year, which is a Monday, we will gather about 800 to 1,000 teachers, to attend our Teachers' National Summit. This will be from 1:00 to 4:00 in the afternoon at the Batasan Hills National High School, Batasan Road, Quezon City. Afterwards, we will march to the Batasan Pambansa to present our proposed bill for the upgrading of our teachers' salaries. At the same time, we will also listen to the privilege speech of our congressman who will pay tribute to the teachers during this year's World Teachers' Day.

This significant event will highlight the kick-off of our campaign to upgrade the teachers salary by making the entry level of public school teachers Salary Grade 15 instead of the present entry level of Salary Grade 11. This will at least level off with those in the military who are in Salary Grade 15 now and have the same qualifications and educational attainment as the teachers. We will be inviting legislators whom we expect to support our crusade by filing bills related to this matter.

In view of this may we please request you to be our partner in this major undertaking? Please join us on this significant day and *deliver your inspirational message* to our teacher participants. We have also invited the Hon. Sec. of Education Jesli Lapus in this occasion. May we also request for a *memorandum official time* for at least two to three faculty club officers or teacher representatives from each school in Metro Manila?

Is it also possible to appeal for financial assistance for the snacks (1,000 participants @ P30.00 = P30,000.00) and kits (about P10,000.00) of participants?
