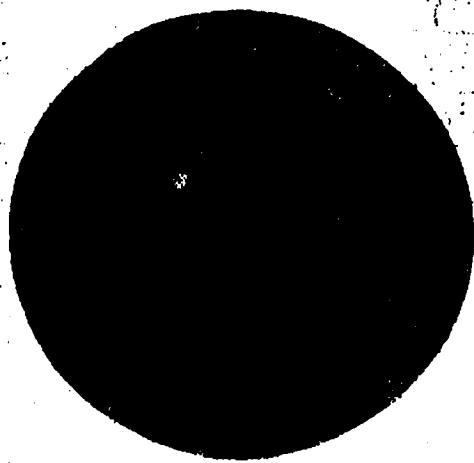

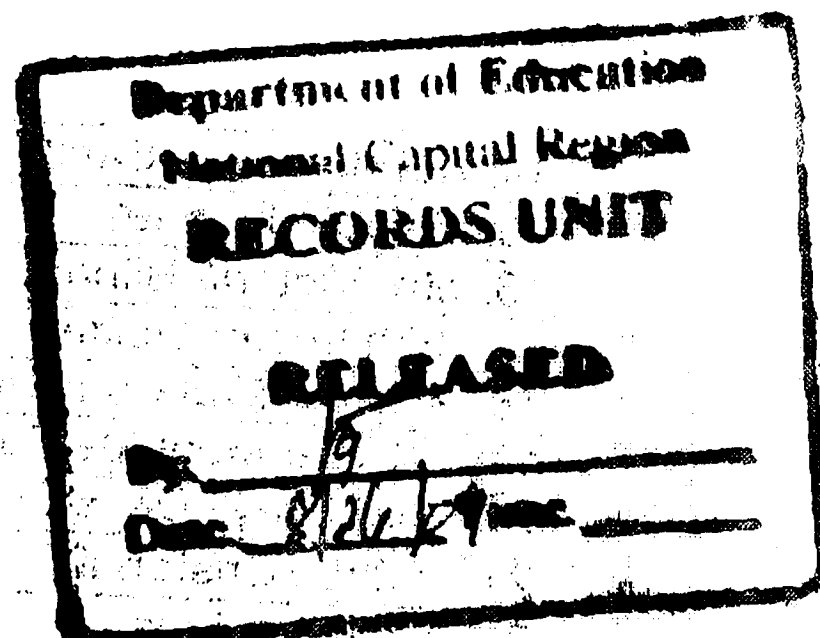

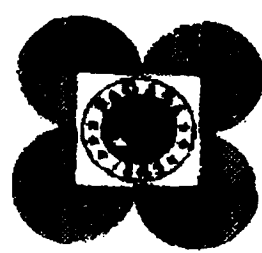
In connection with the foregoing, may we request your office to disseminate our sincere gratitude to all the concerned school heads and pupils/students for their participation including the outcome of the contest.

On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest "Pag Alerto, Malayo sa Peligro"

Children have always been our inspiration to work harder to pursue our endeavors. They bring us hope and peace in this seemingly chaotic environment. Their carefree attitude and positive outlook often teach us lessons on how to view things in the proper perspective. Enhancing the awareness of our children on disaster risk reduction in view of a changing climate is a most fitting investment to advance our causes to make this planet habitable for them in the future.

In the Second Session of the Global Platform for Disaster Risk Reduction held in Geneva from 16-19 June 2009, the youths were given the opportunity to voice out their thoughts. Our very own Rhee Telen from San Francisco, Southern Leyte equated Geneva to a "school for governments" and urged delegates to return to their countries and "do their homework" on disaster risk reduction with a view to include young people in the various UNISDR processes.

In its advocacy to stir the imagination and underscore the participation of the school children and youth in disaster risk reduction and adopting the theme (Pag Alerto, Malayo sa Peligro) of this year's observance of the National Disaster Consciousness Month, the Philippine Meteorological Society (PMS), Inc. in collaboration with the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA-DOST) with support from the Department of Education (DepEd) and the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) conducted the first "On-the Spot Poster making Contest" for public and private elementary and high school students in the National Capital Region (NCR). The preliminary screening was undertaken by the DepEd for 15 high school and elementary divisions in the NCR. The 49 finalists (25 for the elementary level and 24 for the high school level) participated in the contest in the afternoon of 28 July 2009 at the Amihan Conference Room, PAGASA Main Office, Agham Road, Diliman, Quezon City.

The awarding ceremony was highlighted by the message of the PAGASA Administrator, Dr. Prisco D. Nilo, who emphasized the importance of collaborative and participative disaster mitigation program. He also stressed the need to teach our students and the youth of their crucial role as champions in effective disaster risk reduction by assisting in information dissemination in their respective families and communities.

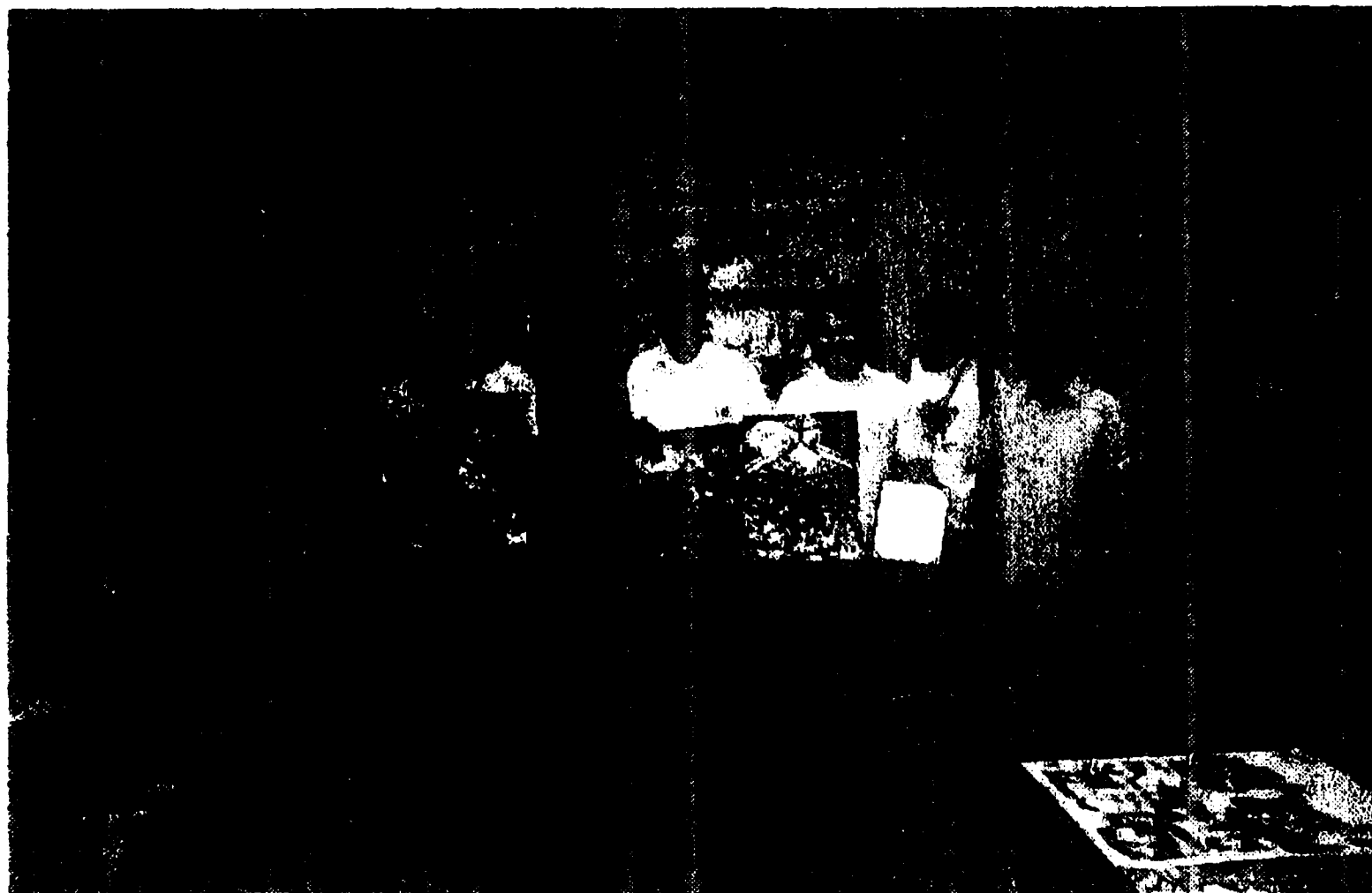

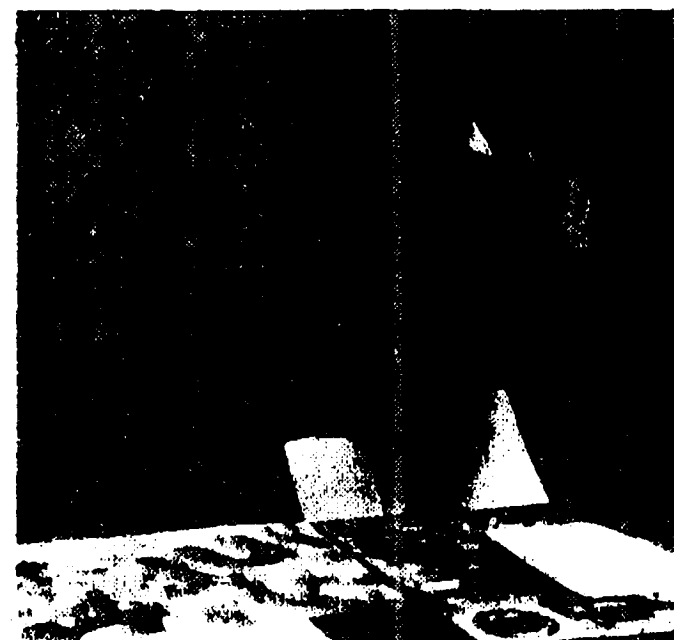

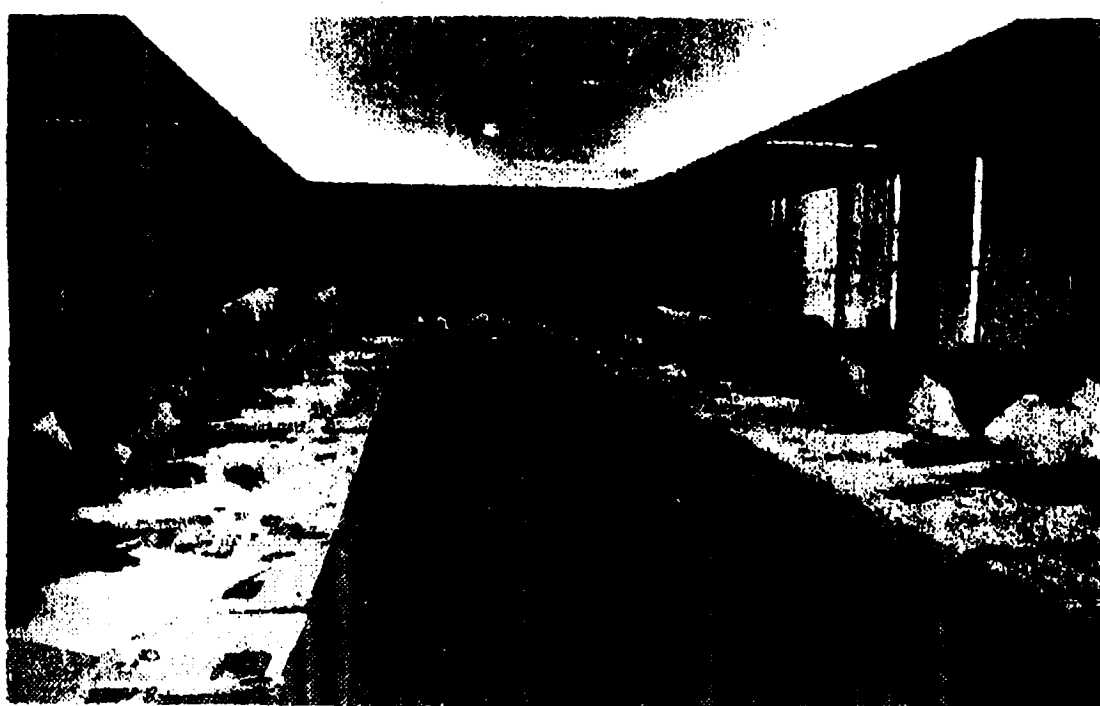
