



Dear Director RUIZ:

This is to inform you that PHIVOLCS, together with Office of Civil Defense, PAGASA, NAMRIA and Mines and Geosciences Bureau are implementing three projects related to disaster preparedness for Metro Manila. The first is entitled "Enhancing Greater Metro Manila's (GMMA) Institutional Capacities for Effective Disaster/Climate Risk Management towards Sustainable Development" or READY for GMMA, 2) Enhancing Risk Analysis Capacities for Flood, Tropical Cyclone Severe Wind and Earthquake for Greater Metro Manila Area or Risk Analysis Project, and 3) Building Community Resilience and Strengthening Local Government Capacities for Recovery and Disaster Risk Management or Resilience Project. The study area covers Metro Manila and surrounding provinces of Rizal, Bulacan, Laguna and Cavite. Common to these projects is the development of a Metro Manila-wide exposure database whose contents would include demography, socio-economic as well as building and critical facilities database. The idea is to be able to put the database into a uniform and easy-to-use system that can be used for emergency response, scenario and landuse planning.

PHIVOLCS is assigned as the lead agency for the exposure database development. Since schools are among the critical facilities that must be put in a database, we would like to request for the said private and public educational facility data including location and/or size of buildings in the National Capital Region. Data format should preferably be in GIS, hard copy maps/plans or plain tabular format. We have also co-developed a list of data that a typical local government unit might need to know during an emergency and these are listed in the attached form. In the future, we hope that the data we can get from you would fill most of the needed information in this form. But for current purposes, may we request that the form be filled for Taguig City schools. Taguig City is the LGU being piloted under the Risk Analysis Project whose timeline is much earlier than the two other projects. Eventually though, we hope to get filled up forms for the rest of the NCR schools. Dr. M.L.P.Bautista (Tel 426 1468 / 0927 296 2349) will coordinate with you regarding this matter. Thank you for your usual kind operation.
