

Program Overview

The two (2) hour-workshop encourages participants to discover the value of committing to one's personal development through building on the HERO Currency. It introduces basic tools such as the hero passbook, calendar and game plan to aid in harnessing one's greatness and in becoming a hero to one's self and others.


