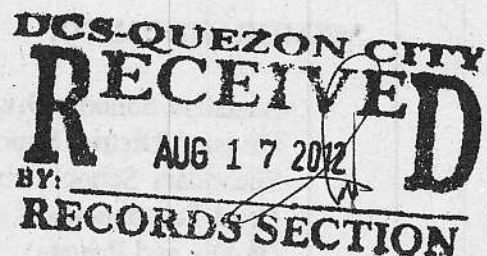

I. THEME: NTC @ 84: Preserving and Reshaping Amidst Educational Reforms

II. OBJECTIVES:

- A. Show the potent role of the changing educational system that will benefit the new generation;
