2012 DIVISION SECONDARY SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendents
Division Supervisors
Secondary Schools Principals
Head Teachers and Teachers In-Charge
(Public and Private Schools)

- The Division of City Schools, Quezon City, in coordination with the Quezon City Secondary School Paper Advisers Association (QCSSPAA), will hold its Division Secondary Schools Press Conference on September 7, 11-14, 2012 at Juan Sumulong High School, Quezon City.
- Participants to this conference are selected campus journalists with their respective school paper advisers.
 Each school publication may send not more than twenty-one (21) delegates. Delegates should report to the
 designated contest venues in their school uniforms except for the Photojournalism and Sports contests where
 they must be in P.E. uniform.
- Individual and group contests both in English and Filipino categories include the following:

a. Editorial Writing

e. Copyreading/Headline Writing

b. Feature Writing

f. Editorial Cartooning

c. News Writing

g. Photojournalism (Digital)

d. Sports Writing

h. Radio Broadcasting

- The Photojournalism contest will be held on September 7, 2012 (8:00 11:00 a.m.) at the Quezon City Circle. During the contest, participants should use only point-and-shoot digital cameras (max. of 14.1 megapixels) with formatted memory cards. Sharing of cameras is discouraged. The top 15 entries for English and 15 for Filipino will represent the division in the Regional Secondary Schools Press Conference.
- 5. The Sports Coverage and contest will be held on September 12, 2012 (8:00 a.m. 12:00 noon) at Juan Sumulong High School.
- 6. The Radio Broadcasting contest is open to all schools, public and private. Each school may field one team for English and one for Filipino, with seven members each. The contest will be held at the Science Interactive Center on September 13, 2012. English broadcasting will be from 8:00 a.m. 12:00 noon, Filipino will be from 1:00 4:00 p.m.
- 7. As provided for in Sec. 2, Rule V of RA 7070, otherwise known as the "Campus Journalism Act of 1991," incidental expenses relative to the conduct of press conferences may be charged against the school paper funds. In this particular activity, the editorial board, which has the custody of the said funds, shall pay the registration fee of the school's participants in the amount of One Hundred Pesos (Php 100.00) each student and school paper adviser to defray miscellaneous expenses.
- 8. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
