MY Rights- Saving Kids In Peril Inc. exist as an advocacy group that aims to promote positive change by educating children and adults about the rights of a child, urging them to carry out their roles, duties and responsibilities to protect and promote the rights of a child, and saving those kids in peril. The group is known for their project "Klinikantina" regular Monday and Saturday community outreach program; doing feeding, wound cleaning and counseling to troublesome children in the community. 
