



Two modules discuss fundamental issues that require special attention and effective response from educators by enabling them to recognize the hidden hazards in the current moral climate and help them formulate an action plan that will help young people counteract the attacks against their family, their dignity and their faith

Many families today suffer. In spite of their sincere efforts to love and care for their children, parents find it more difficult each day to raise their family. Parents and educators generally know that environmental factors affect children negatively. But what exactly are these factors? We need to pinpoint them, if we are to protect the family. A vague idea of these attacks against the family will not suffice to correct the family's deteriorating situation today.
