MECHANICS & CRITERIA

QUIZ VI - Bulwagan ng Karunungan, DepED, July 31, 2012, 8:00 - 10:00 A.M.

I. Description:

The Quiz VI shall provide the venue where Visually Impaired pupils in the elementary (Grade IV-VI) level to demonstrate their academic skills.

II. Mechanics

The questionnaire will be prepared by DepED Central Office.

One set of questionnaires will be formulated and designed for elementary level pupils (Grade IV-VI). The questionnaires will be divided into three (3) parts: Easy, Average and Difficult.

Each part will have ten (10) items.

- Each correct answer will have equivalent points: Easy 1 point, Average 2 points, 4. and Difficult - 3 points.
- Questions will be read twice. The contestants will be given ten seconds to write their answers in Braille.
- The garnered points of each contestants will be computed and to be announced
- The contestant who shall acquire the first three highest points shall be the First, Second and Third Prize Winners

In case of tie, a set of tie breaking questions will be prepared.

- All winners will be announced after the computations of scores have been 9.
- 10. Awarding of Prizes will be done after the computations.

III. Criteria:

1. Contestants must be currently enrolled in Grade IV - VI in any schools/SPED Center.

2. He/she must be certified by his/her SPED teacher

- 3. Contestant must have knowledge and skills in Braille reading & writing.
- 4. Registration of participants should not be later than July 30, 2012

BRAILLE READING CONTEST - Bulwagan ng Karunungan, DepED, July 31, 2012, 11:00 -12; AM

Description:

This contest is intended for the visually impaired students in the Secondary Level. Participants are currently enrolled or out-of-school students. They should be fast Braille readers and have good diction and expression in reading.

II. Mechanics:

- Participants must be currently enrolled in the secondary schools or out-of-school students.
- 2. She must be certified by his/her SPED Center
- 3. Participants must be fast Braille readers with good diction and expression
- 4. Registration of participants should not be later than July 30, 2012.

III. Criteria

- 1. Speed in reading 50%
- Diction and expression in reading

IV. Prizes

1st Prize - Gold Medal plus a cash prize
2nd Prize - Silver Medal plus a cash prize
3nd Prize - Bronze Medal plus a cash prize

C. EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEECH CONTEST (Bulwagan ng Karunungan, DepED)

I. Description:

Topics will be given by the committee hosting this contest. A number of topics shall be prepared and each participant will pick out one which he/she is going to talk about. They will be given ample time to study the topic. When the allotted time given to them is finished, participants will draw lots for their respective number in delivering their speech. An ample time will be set by the committee for each participant to deliver their topic.

II. Mechanics:

- 1. Participants must be currently enrolled or out-of-school students in the college level.
- Judges of this contest shall come from other agencies other than the DepED, RBI and PAVIC.
- 3. Registration of participants should not be later than July 30, 2012.

III. Criteria:

- 1. Relevance of the speech according to the given topic 50%
- 2. Volume of voice and expression of the speaker while delivering his/her speech 30%
- 3. Audience impact 20%

IV. Prizes

1st Prize - Gold Medal plus cash prize
2nd Prize - Silver Medal plus cash prize
3nd Prize - Bronze Medal plus a cash prize

D. BRAILLE EASSY WRITING CONTEST

1. Description:

This contest is intended for all persons with visual impairment who are capable of composing and writing an essay in Braille. Participants from all schools/SPED Centers are welcome to join this contest. SPED teachers should endorse the registration and entries of their participants from their respective schools.

II. Mechanics:

- 1. Title of the essay is MAKING THE RIGHTS REAL RIGHT NOW! For Persons with Visual Impairment.
- 2. Participants must be knowledgeable of fully contracted Braille.
- 3. Entries must be written in fully Braille contractions.
- 4. Entries must be composed of not more than 300 words.
- 5. Submission of entries should not be later than July 30, 2012.
- 6. Complete data information of each participant should be included with their entries.

III. Criteria:

- 1. Contents of entries must be based on the topic given 40%
- 2. Compliance to instruction 30%
- 3. Correct spelling and utilization of punctuation marks 20 %
- 4. Neatness of work 10%

1st Prize - Gold Medal plus cash prize 2nd Prize - Silver Medal plus cash prize 3rd Prize - Bronze Medal plus cash prize
