Greetings from the U.P. College of Music - Music Education Department!

In celebration of the 98th anniversary of the UP College of Music and the 45th anniversary of the Music Education Department, the Music Education Department in cooperation with the Philippine Society for Music Education and the U.P. Junior Music Educators' Guild would like to invite teachers from the NCR and nearby provinces to the Teaching Demonstration Series 16 at the Abelardo Hall, U.P. College of Music this coming September 6, 2012 from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm. This year's theme is "Exploring Music in the K-12 Curriculum".

The objective of the project is to update pre-school, elementary and secondary school music teachers/teachers teaching music on teaching techniques based on current trends and learning theories as well as instructional materials in the teaching of Music. Demonstrations will be given to pre-school, elementary and high school children by outstanding UP Music Education students. The last session will also include a choral and vocal technique workshop.
