The 2012 ALL-STARS REGIONAL SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIP

- The 2012 ALL-STARS REGIONAL SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIP is a day swim meet to be held at Rizal Memorial Swim Complex on September 30, 2012.
- The 2012 ALL-STARS REGIONAL SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIP is an exciting swimming event providing an opportunity for developing swimmers to represent as an individual and team member in a national event. The event is open to Elementary, High School and College levels both private and public schools.
- The Philippine Swim League is the National University Swimming Federation under FESSAP is once more honored to send elite swimmers to represent the Philippines in the **27th Summer Universiade to be held in Kazan, Russia.**
- This 2012 ALL-STARS REGIONAL SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIP will serve as an avenue of PSL's participations for the forthcoming invitational meets abroad like Thailand, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Malaysia, Singapore, and Indonesia, also in ASEAN University Games and ASIAN University Games in school years 2012-2013-2014.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The 2012 **All-Stars Regional Swimming Championship** shall be conducted under the Rules of PHILIPPINE SWIM LEAGUE as prescribed in the FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DE NATION ("FINA") Handbook 2009-2013. One-Start Rule applies.

- Events listed below will be for both men and women:

Freestyle:	50m, 100m, 200m and 400m
Backstroke:	50m, 100m and 200m
Breaststroke:	50m, 100m and 200m
Butterfly:	50m, 100m and 200m
Individual Medley:	200m and 400m

- Format of Competition – The Championships are run in Long-Course Meters (LCM) format and the following manner:
- Elementary Competitor (6 yrs. Old and below, 7-8,9-10,11-12 yrs. old)
- High school competitor (13-14 and 15-16yrs. old)
- College competitor (17 – 28 yrs. old)

Separate Results for Elementary-High School and College in awarding.

Top two (2) fastest time qualified swimmers in elementary, high school and college will be eligible to participate in our scheduled invitational swim competitions abroad.

- PHILIPPINE SWIM LEAGUE reserves the right to the final decision on all matters pertaining to the selection for delegation officials and athletes as scheduled.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

- Philippine Swim League Technical must be provided with Swimmer's Entry Sheet on or before September 25, 2012 by the team head coach. Permanent School Record (Form 137) of Athletes duly signed and authenticated by the school principal together with a photocopy of swimmer's NSO Birth Certificate. Attached is the Team's Gallery form to be submitted to PSL during the FINAL MEETING OF COACHES AND SCREENING OF DOCUMENTS on September 29 (9:00 am) Saturday at Bernabe Elementary School, Pasay City.
- Swimmer must be a bonafide student of their school.
(as shown in their Registration/Certificate of Enrolment duly signed by current school principal in school year 2012-2013)
- All events will be swum as Timed Finals
- ATHLETE'S WAIVER IS REQUIRED TO ALL SWIMMING PARTICIPANTS.
- **Entries close at 12midnight Tuesday, 25th September 2012.**
- **No late entries will be accepted.**
- Entry fee: P400.00 regular registration or P100 only for public school students upon presentation of Certificate of Enrolment for verifications.
- A maximum of 4 individual events per athlete will be allowed.

The FIRST REGIONAL SCHOOL BAND COMPETITION

September 30, 2012 (RMSC-Swimming Pool)

■ **MECHANICS OF THE CONTEST**

- The contest is open for all public and private elementary and secondary schools from the National Capital Region. No participation and entrance fees required to join in.
- Performing bands shall compose not lower than 30 member- participants.
- Presentation shall not exceed a 10 minute-performance including entrance and exit in the swimming pool area of activity. Performances will be rendered in the space provided at the pool area including the surroundings or sides of the pool. Scheduled date of band performances will be based on the numbers of participating schools.
- Performing bands may use any percussion or wind instruments with balancers to make their presentation more attractive. Band conductor/leader is optional.
- Food and snacks during the contest and the transportation expenses to and from the venue shall be shouldered by respective participating school band.
