

#### AFSA EXHIBIT

The Exhibit showcases the Association's objective to increase environmental awareness by presenting timely environmental issues and concerns. The Exhibit is usually placed at the Forest Biological Sciences (FBS) Lobby for a week. It shall be open starting from August 13 to 17, 2012

#### PULOT-KALAT SA FLAT ROCKS

A whole-day clean-up activity which aims to promote camaraderie between and among the members of the organization while engaging in beneficial environmental actions. This program is usually done in Flat Rocks in Mount Makiling. This will be held on August 18, 2012.

#### MANGROVE TREE PLANTING (MTP)

In line with the Association's determination to contribute to forest and natural resource restoration, conservation and sustainability, the Mangrove Tree Planting is conducted to rehabilitate degraded mangrove areas. This Tree Planting activity is usually supported by local government units where mangrove sites are located. Through the years, the Association has planted mangrove in Pagbilao, Quezon and in San Juan, Batangas. This year's Tree Planting activity is scheduled on August 25, 2012.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL YOUTH SYMPOSIUM

Apart from promoting academic excellence and environmental consciousness, this activity also aims to orient promising high school students on various career opportunities in the field of forestry. Resource speakers share their knowledge and experience on specific issues. The Symposium will be held at the College of Forestry and Natural Resources (CFNR) Auditorium on September 3, 2012.
