

- 3. The essay must espouse on the given theme.
- 4. The essay may be in Filipino or English, Times New Roman, 12, double-spaced with a minimum of 1,000 to maximum of 2,000 words.
- 5. The essay should not bear the name of the student, instead must be accompanied by a duly accomplished entry form signed by the student and the adviser.
- The regional office accepting the entry will put a three-digit control code at the entry form and will mark the same with code at the top right corner of the document.
- 7. The code should bear the following: the letter code of the region (see table below) and the three-digit number starting with double zero. To illustrate, entry forms from Region I, the control code for the first entry received would be B-001 and so on.


