This is to inform all Non-Teaching Personnel in this Office that they can now submit their application for monetization. Secondary Schools can claim their monetization from their own savings.

Under CSC Sec. 22. Monetization of Leave Credits – Officials and employees in the career and non-career service whether permanent, temporary, casual, or coterminous, who have accumulated fifteen (15) days of vacation leave credits shall be allowed to monetize a minimum of ten (10) days: Provided, that at least five (5) days is retained after monetization and provided further that a maximum of thirty (30) days may be monetized in a given year. (Provided for under CSC MC No. 41., s. 1998)

This Office is granting a maximum of ten (10) days monetization subject to the availability of funds.

Approved Application for Leave (Form 6) is required for the said claim.

Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is hereby enjoined.
