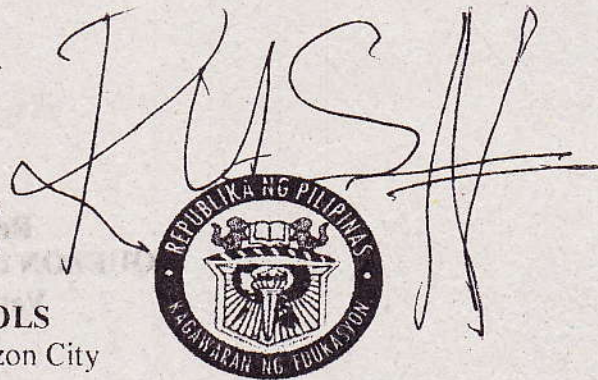

(Responsible Pet Owner by Prevention and Management)


